Please read through the entire application and use the **Requirements Checklist** below to ensure all necessary information and documentation are included in your application. All documents must have original hand-written signatures (excluding birth documents). Photocopied, faxed, scanned, or emailed applications will **NOT** be accepted. Any missing information or documentation will result in a delay of your application.

**NOTE: This document is a fillable PDF, which allows you to type in your information, however all signatures must still be hand written on the printed form.**

### Entitlement to Métis Nation of Alberta Citizenship

**“Métis”**– a person who self identifies as Métis, is distinct from other Aboriginal peoples, is of historic Métis Nation ancestry and is accepted by the Métis Nation.

**An individual who self-identifies as Métis, must provide historical proof of his or her Métis ancestry:**

- Historic proof showing evidence of an ancestor who received a land grant, or a scrip grant under the Manitoba Act or the Dominion Lands Act, or who was recognized as a Métis in other government, church, or community records;
- Historic Métis Nation means the Indigenous people then known as Métis or Half-Breeds who resided in historic Métis Nation Homeland;
- Historic Métis Nation Homeland means the area of land in west central North America used and occupied as the traditional territory of the Métis or Half-Breeds, as they were then known.

**Métis Homeland:** The Homeland, geographically, embraces all three prairie provinces (Manitoba, Saskatchewan, and Alberta) also parts of Ontario, Northwest Territories, British Columbia, and parts of the United States.

### Birth Documents

To complete your application, you must obtain a copy of ONE of the below birth documents.

#### Acceptable Birth Documents:

- Live Birth Registration
- Long Form Birth Certificate showing the full names of biological parents
- Wallet-size Birth Certificate PLUS a copy of baptismal certificate with church seal (legible) and officiates signature

You can request birth documents from the Vital Statistics Department of the province of your birth. Please ensure requested documents show parentage. For a list of available resources visit [albertamemis.com/registry/genealogy](http://albertamemis.com/registry/genealogy)

### Current Photo Identification

If mailing in your application, please provide a copy of current photo identification. If the applicant is under 18 years of age, the parent or guardian signing the application must present current photo identification, not the applicant.

#### Acceptable Photo Identification:

- Driver's License
- Alberta Identification Card
- Firearms License
- Passport PLUS proof of residency in Alberta for 90 consecutive days

## Proof of Alberta Residency

You may be required to provide proof of permanent residency in Alberta for a minimum of ninety (90) consecutive days.

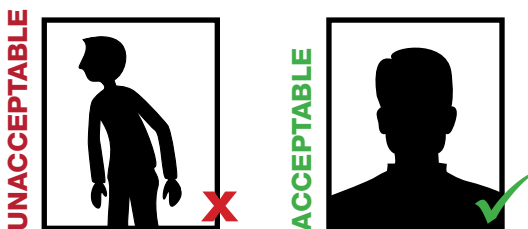
### Acceptable Proof of Residency:

- Alberta driver's license
- Three (3) consecutive months of utility bills (mobile phone records will not be accepted)
- Vehicle insurance
- Mortgage or rental lease agreement

## Métis Citizenship Card Photo Specifications

Photos for your Métis citizenship card can be taken at the Provincial Head Office, any of the regional offices, or taken at home. If providing your own photo, please ensure it follows the below requirements:

- No filters
- Photos must be in colour
- White or light colored background
- Photos must reflect/represent natural skin tones
- Image must be clear, sharp, and in focus
- Shadows or flash reflection on the face and head will not be accepted
- Shows a full front view of the applicant's face, with face and shoulders centered in the photo and squared to the camera
- Eyes must be open and clearly visible. Glasses may be worn as long as eyes are clearly visible. Sunglasses are not acceptable
- Hats or head coverings are not permitted except when worn for religious reasons and only if the full facial features are clearly visible
- Photos can be emailed to [registry@metis.org](mailto:registry@metis.org) or mailed to the Provincial Head Office. You must include your full name and birth date with all photo submissions.



## Getting Documents Commissioned

In order to complete your application, there are two (2) forms requiring a Commissioner for Oaths' signature. Please note all signatures must be originals. Photocopied, faxed, scanned, or emailed applications will not be accepted.

1. *Statutory Declaration: Not on an Indian Registry/Band List*
2. *Oath of Citizenship*

### Documents can be Commissioned at:

- Insurance agencies, lawyers, or registries (fees may apply)

## Family Tree

All applicants are **required** to provide a completed family tree outlining their **Métis ancestry** to the **mid 1800s**. If you are referencing or linking to another family member's tree, you still must complete your own family tree to the ancestor you both have in common. Please include the full name, relationship to you, and citizen ID of the family member you are referencing on the bottom of your family tree. Additional documentation to support genealogy may be required.
